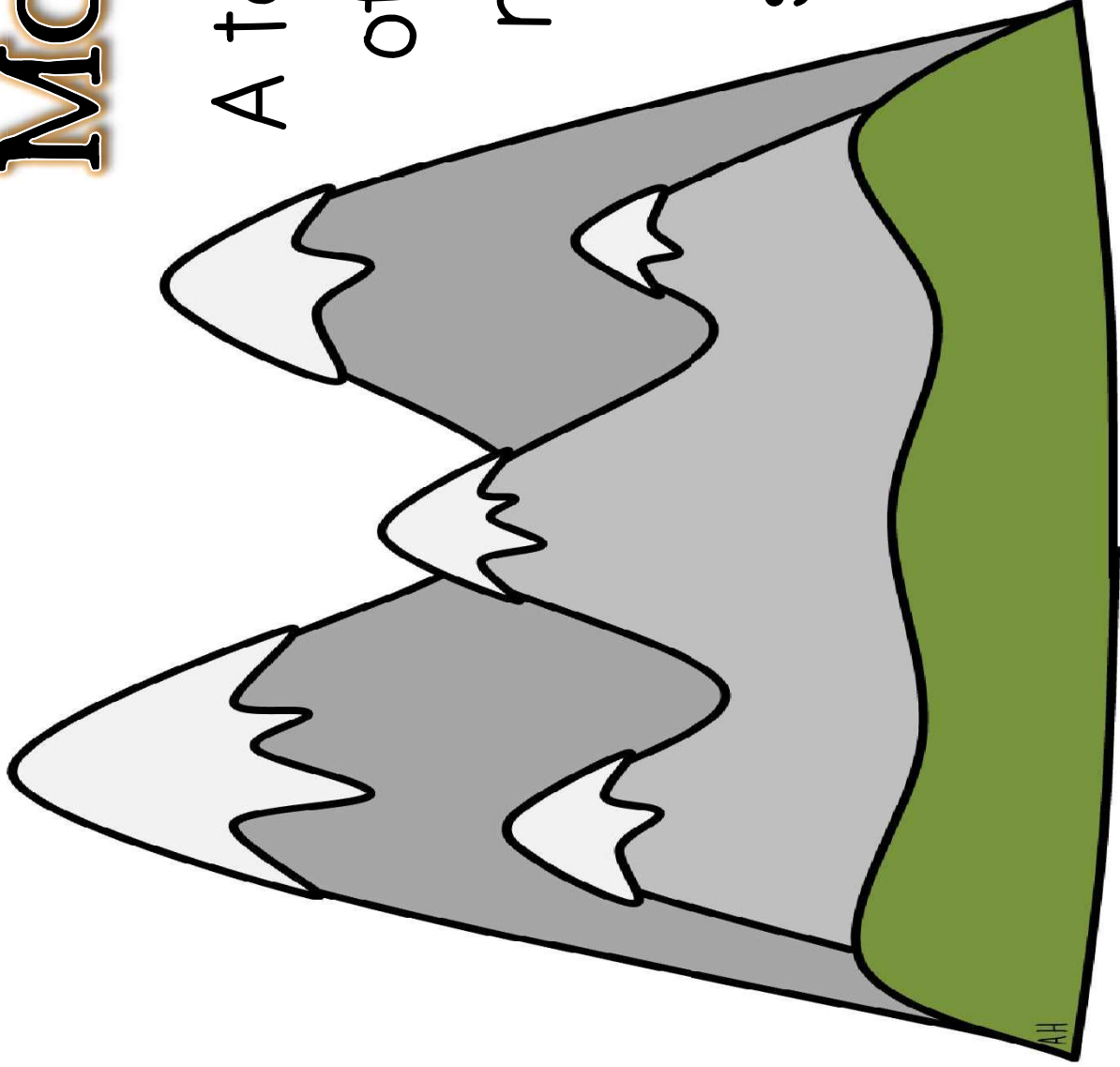


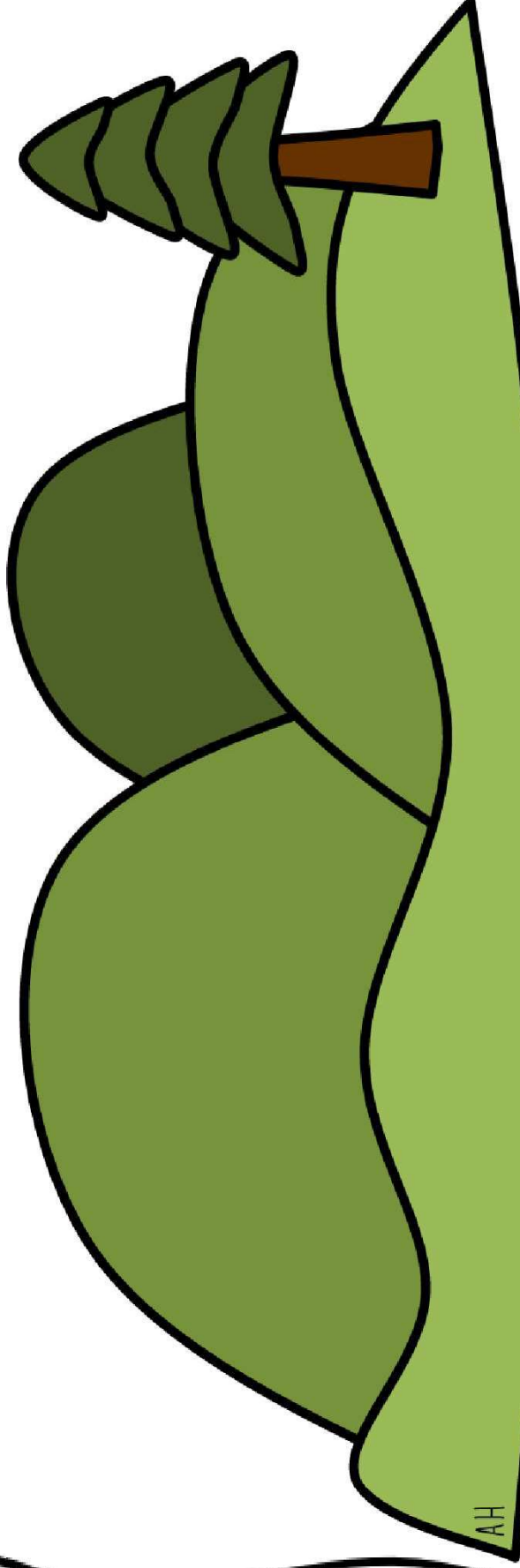
Mountain

land



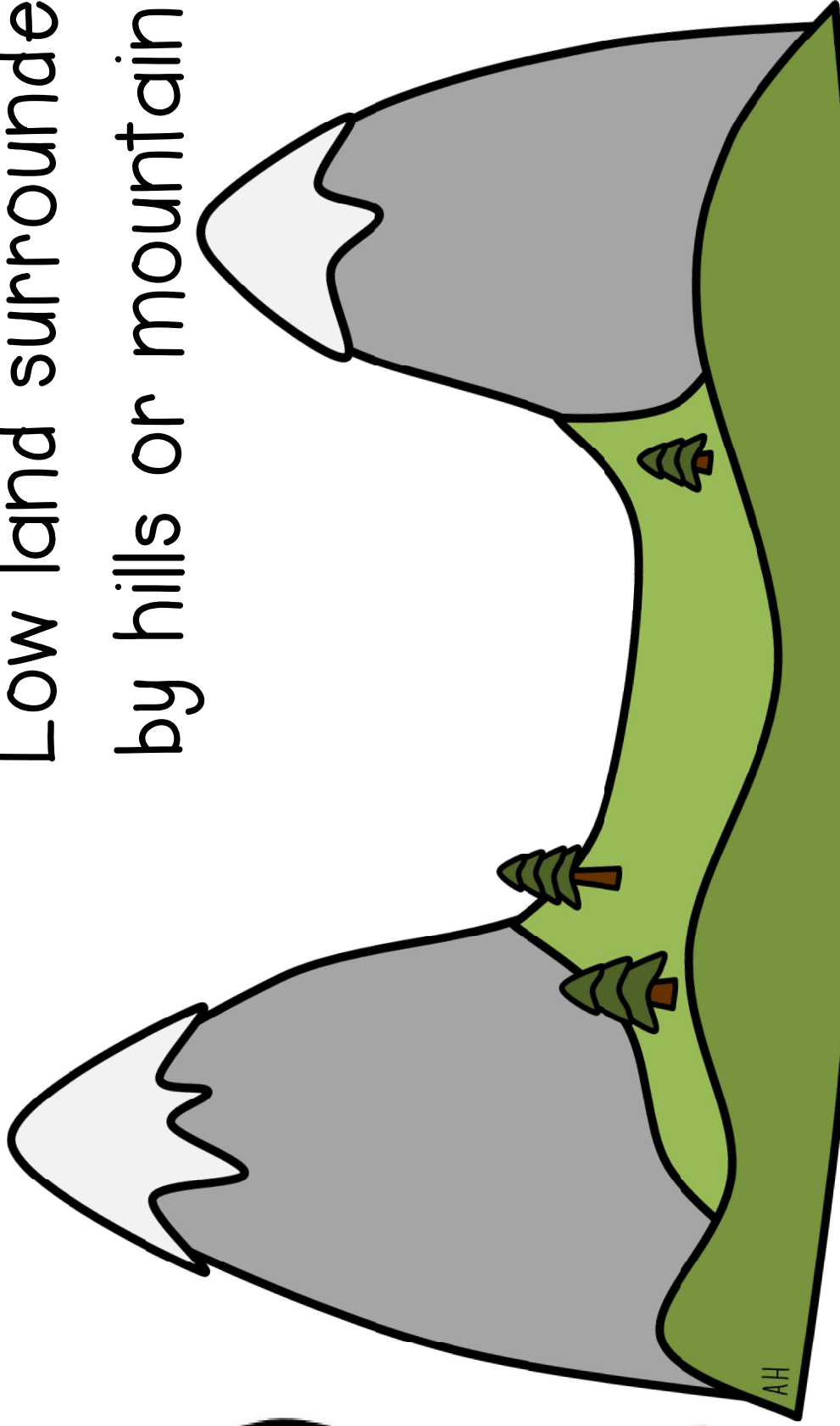
Hill

Valley

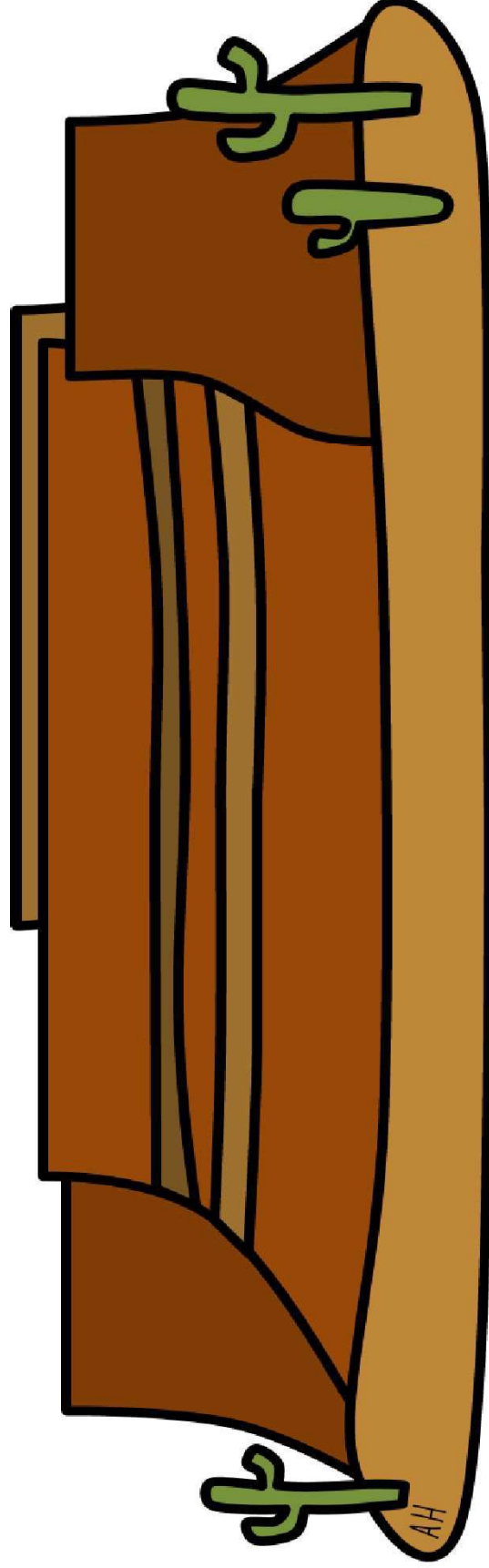
Low land surrounded

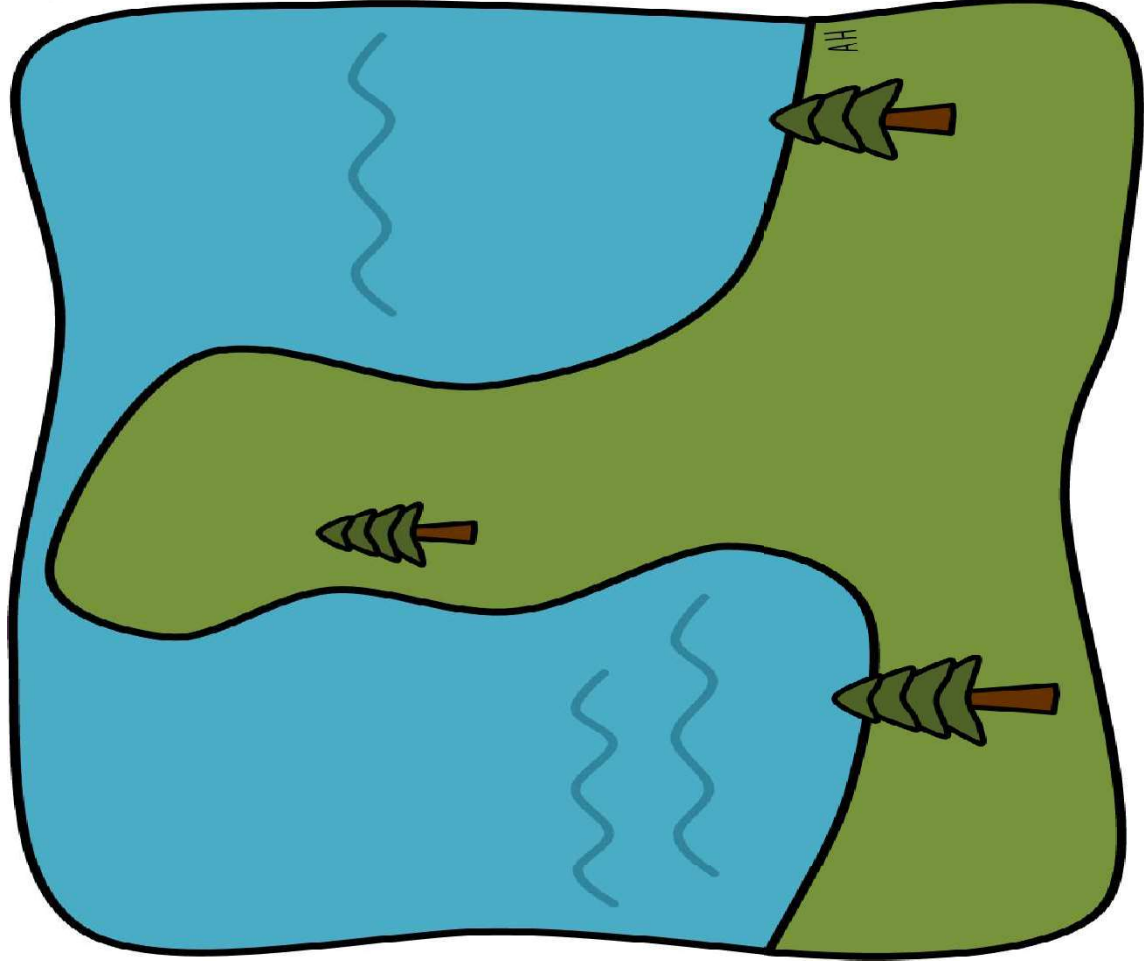
Plateau

An area of land flat on top with steep sides, that is higher than the surrounding land



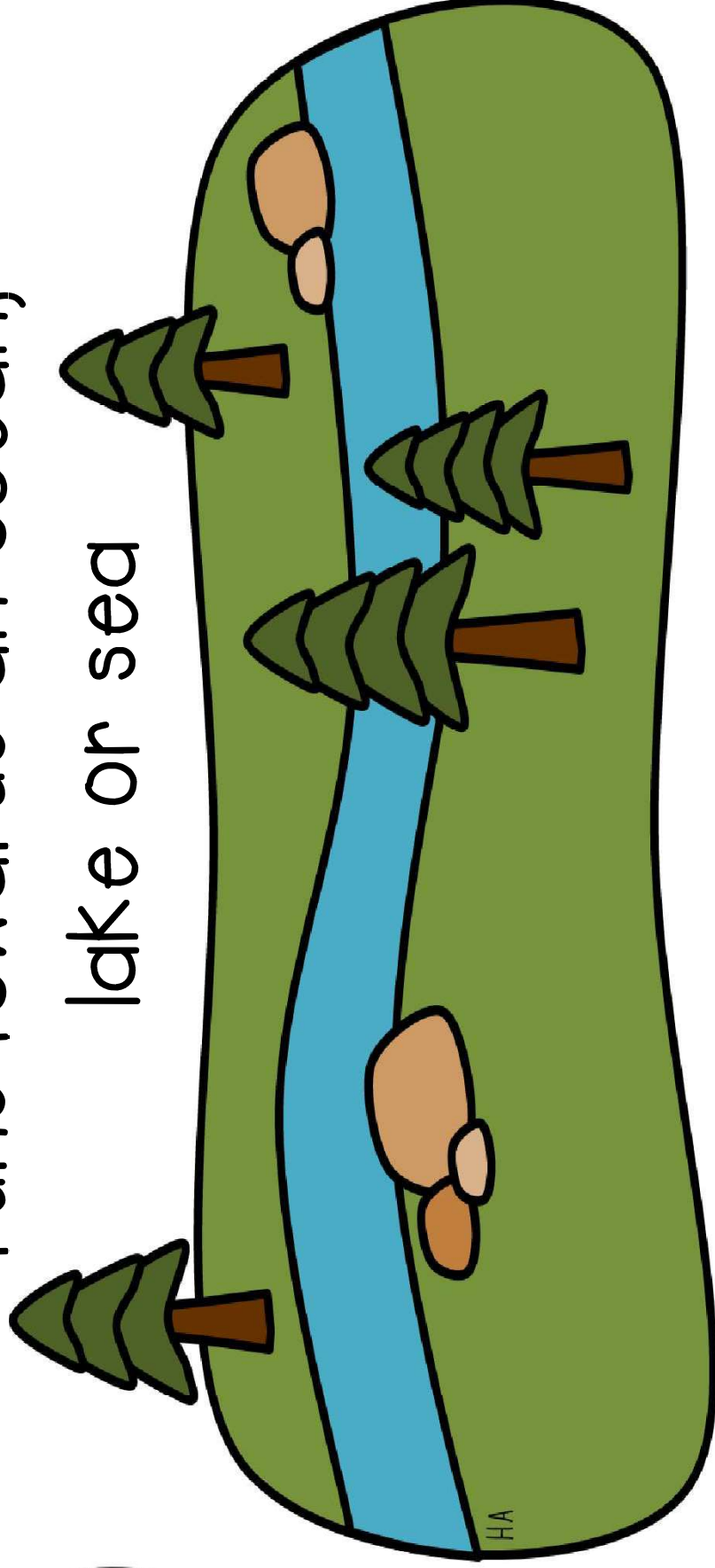
Peninsula

A body of land that is surrounded by water on three sides.



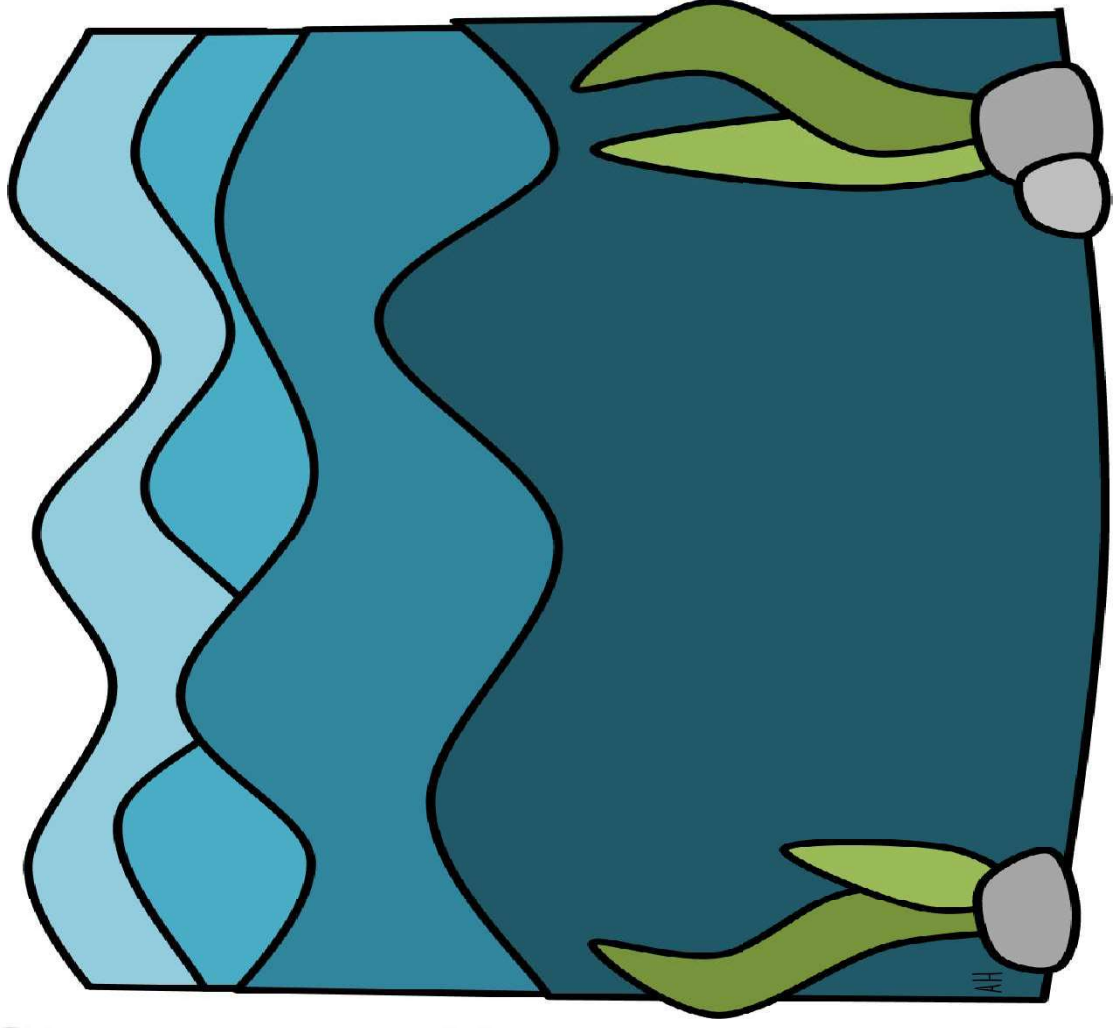
River

lake or sea



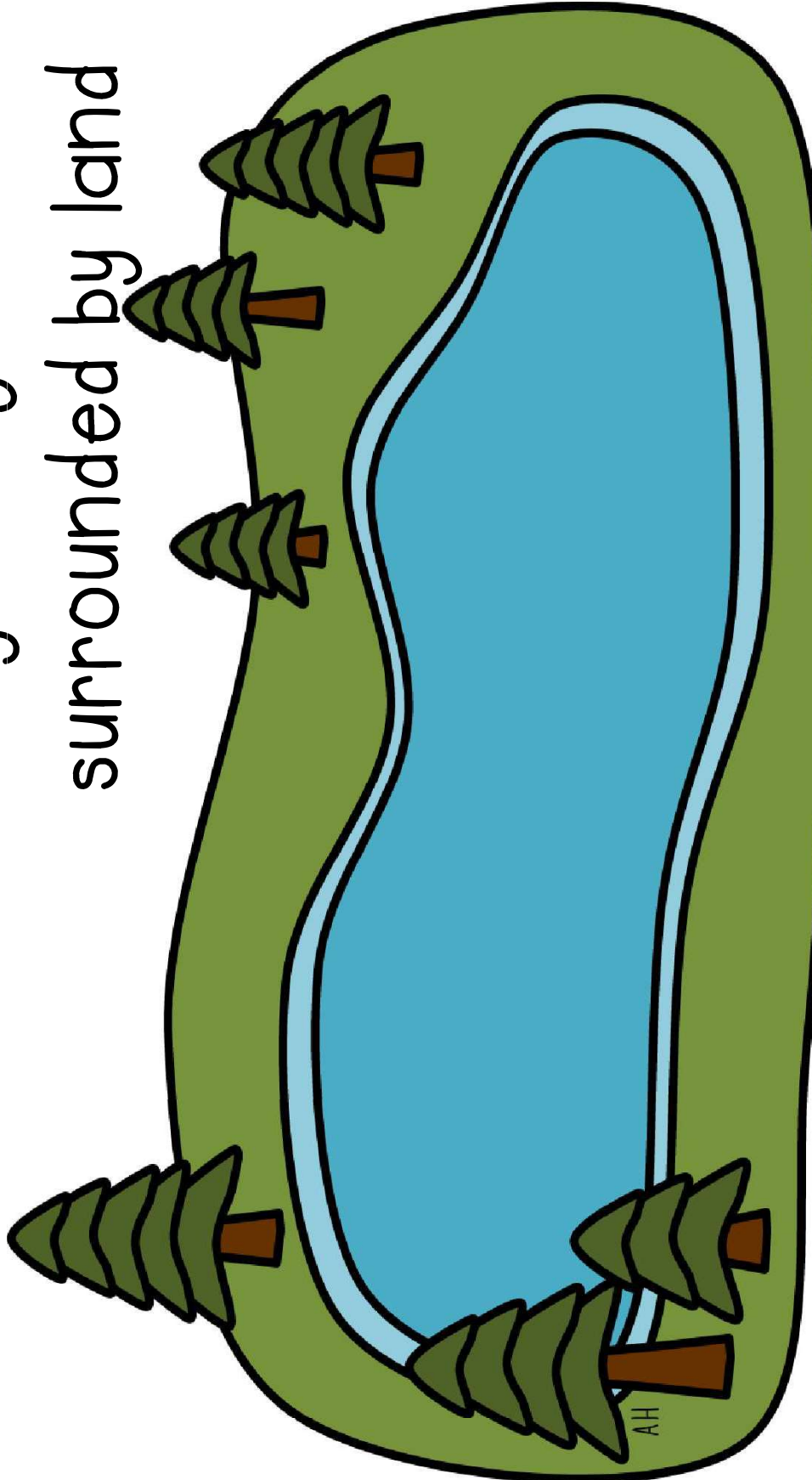
Ocean

a continent.



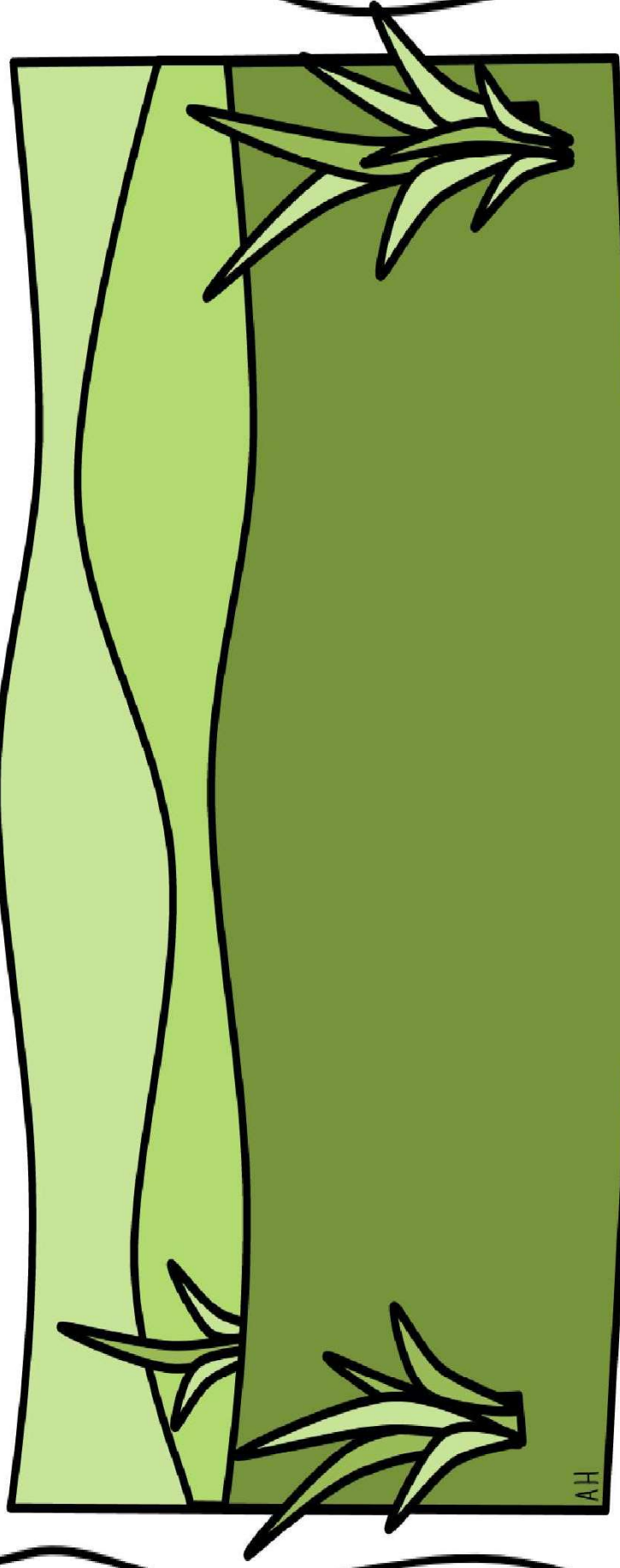
Lake

Plain

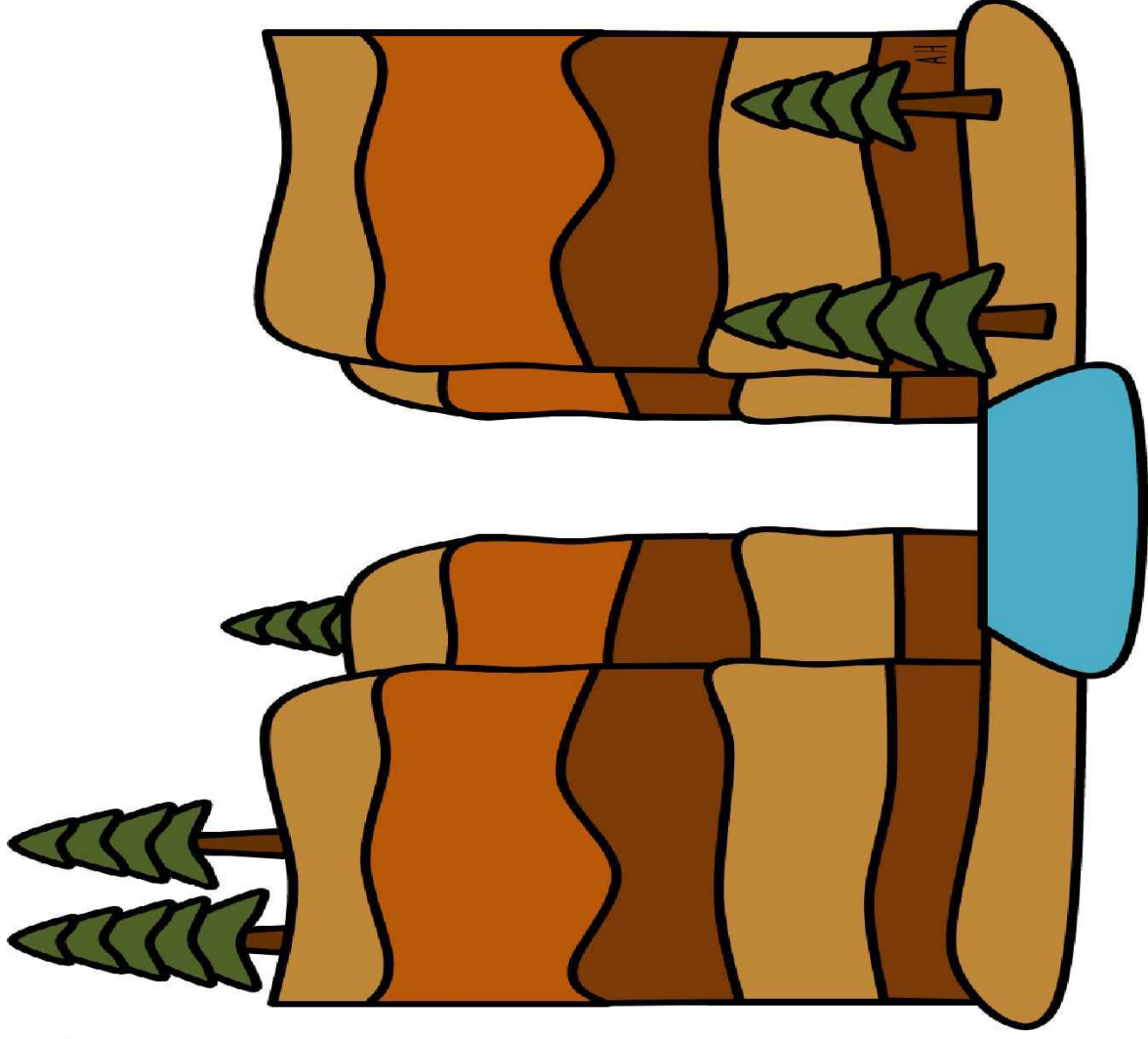
A very large, flat

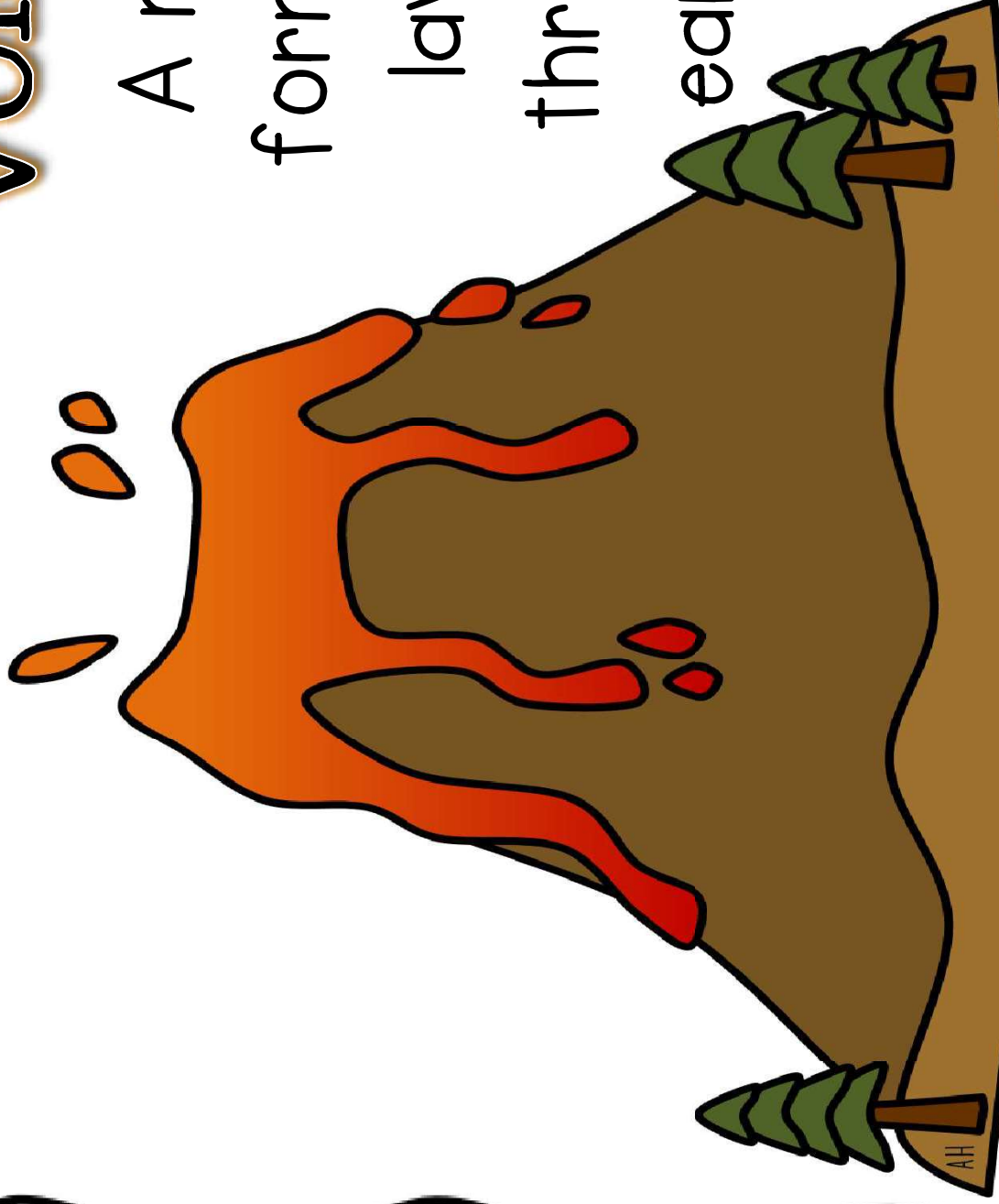
Canyon

by a river



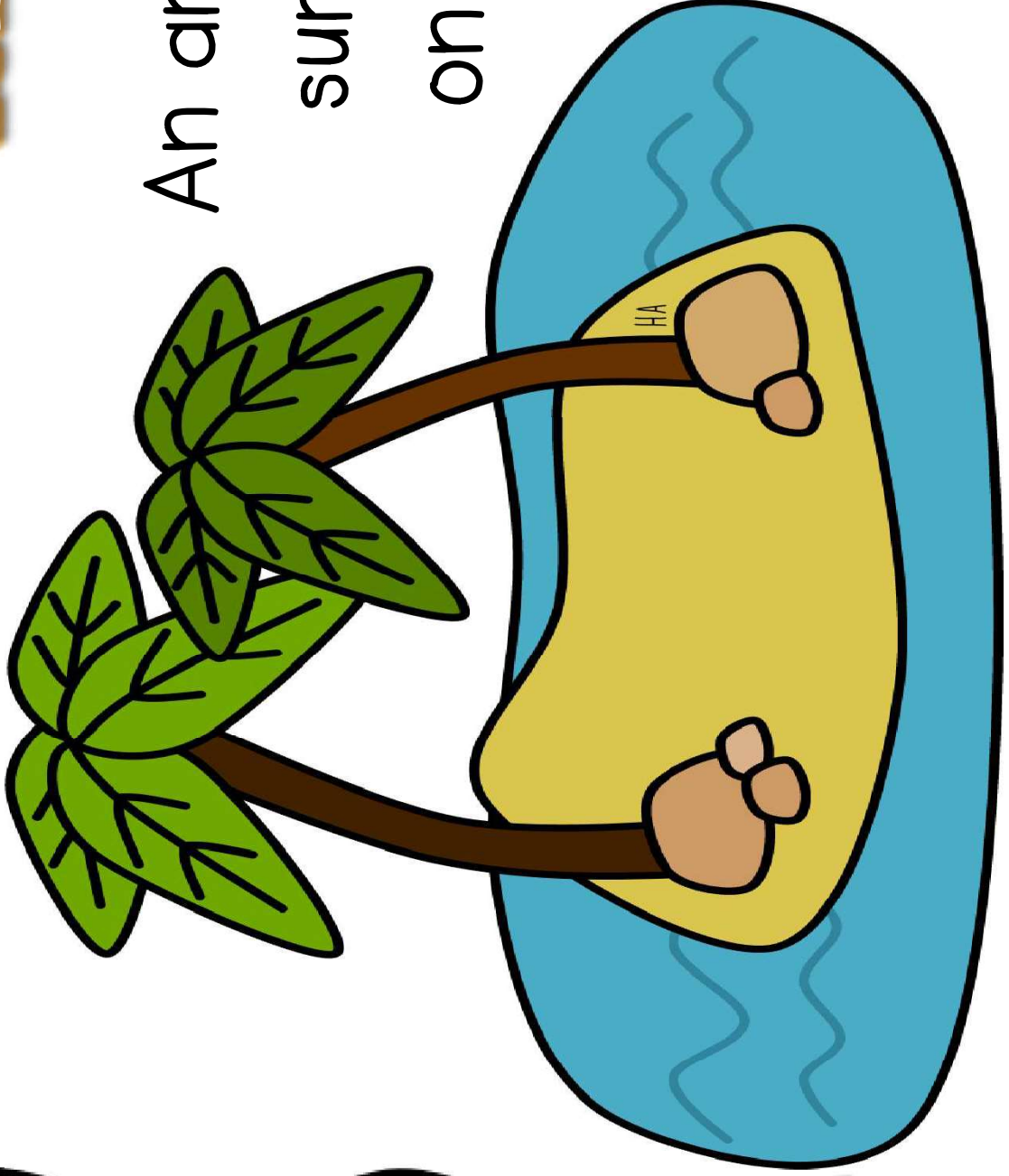
Volcano

earth's crust



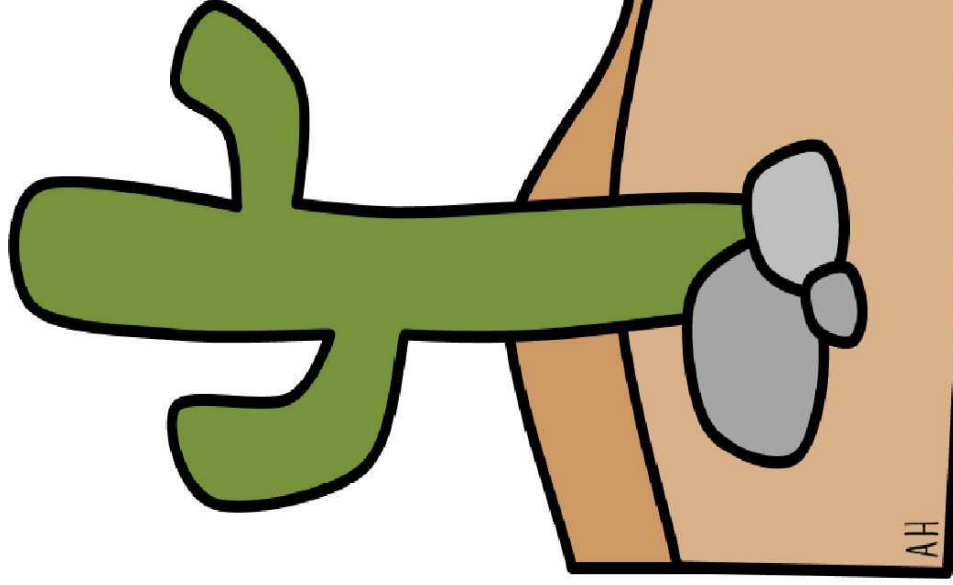
Island

by water



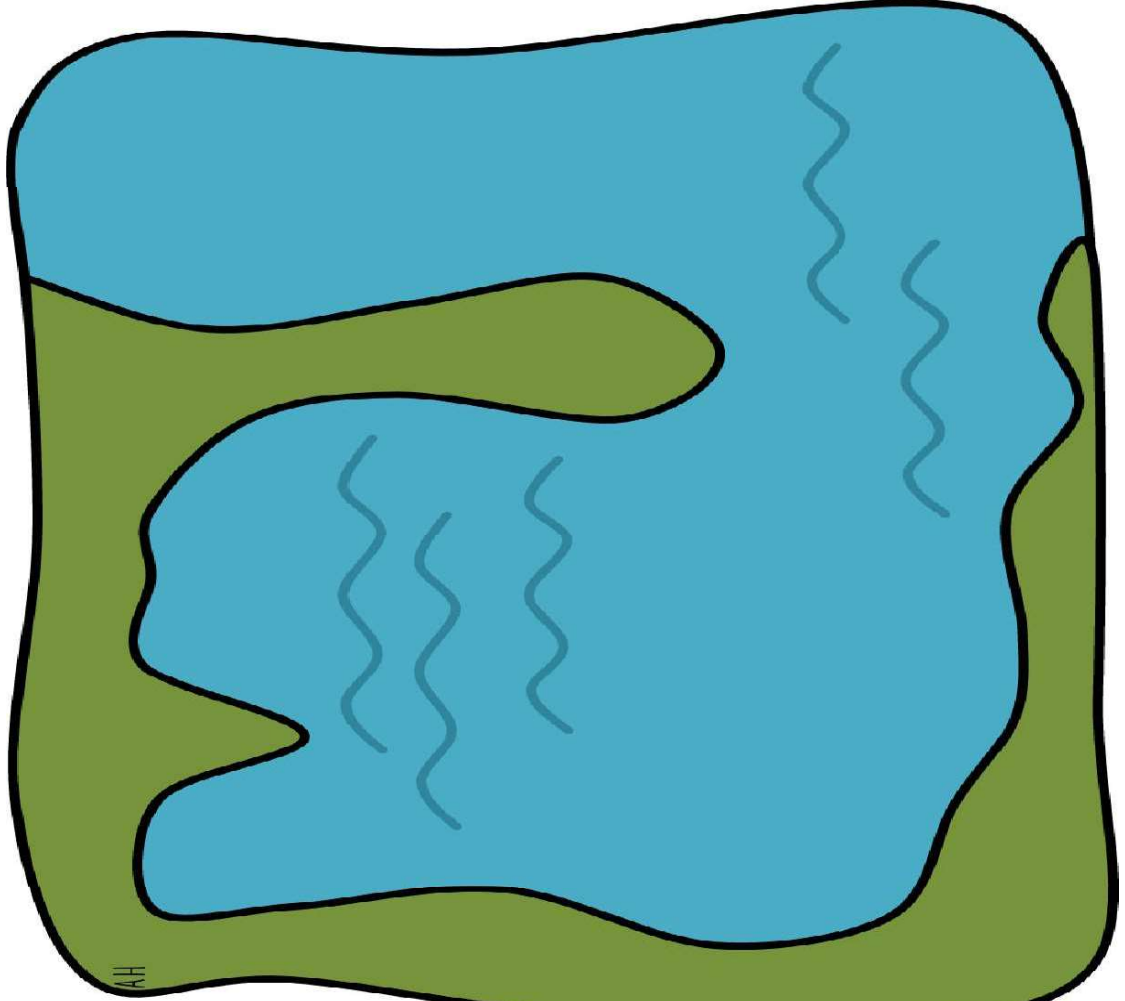
Desert

Glacier

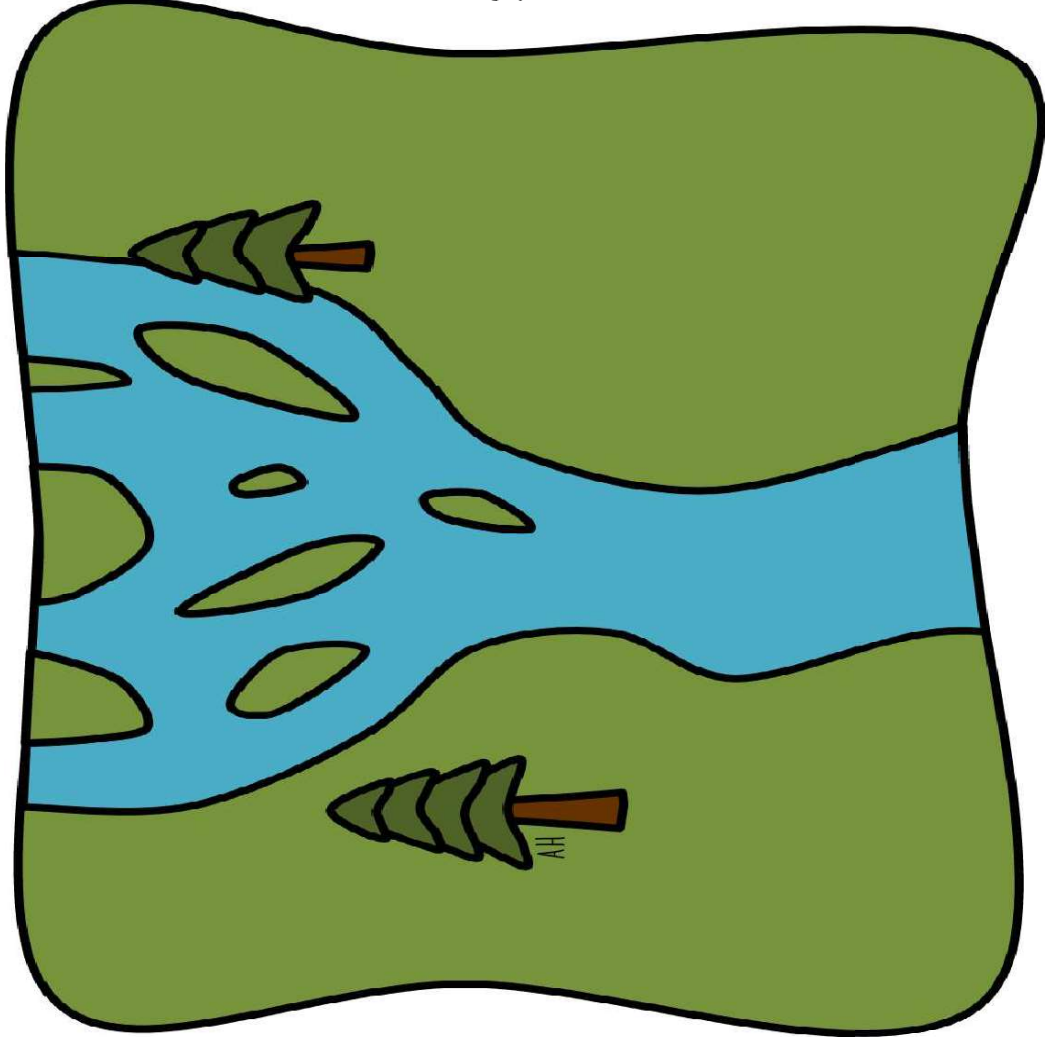
A large body

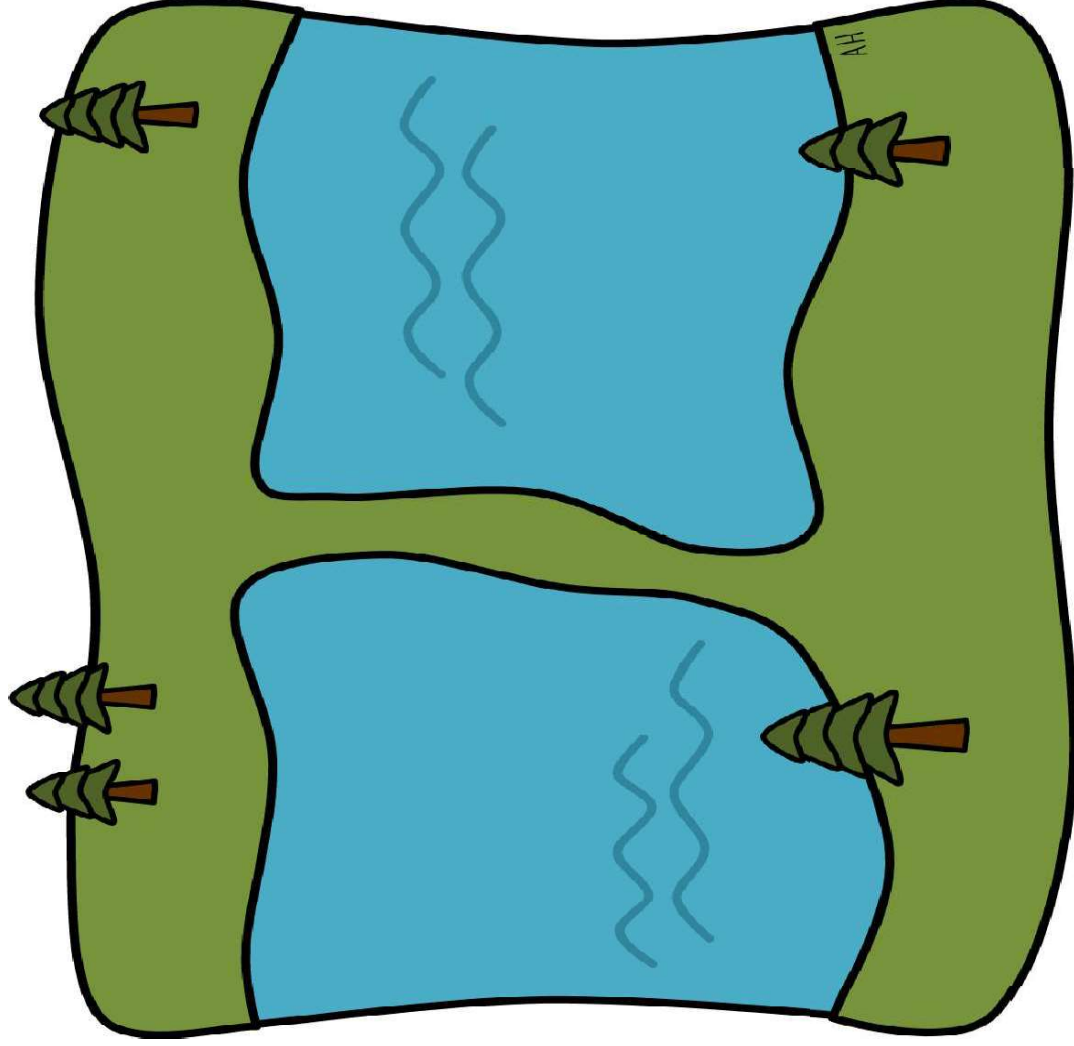
Delta
